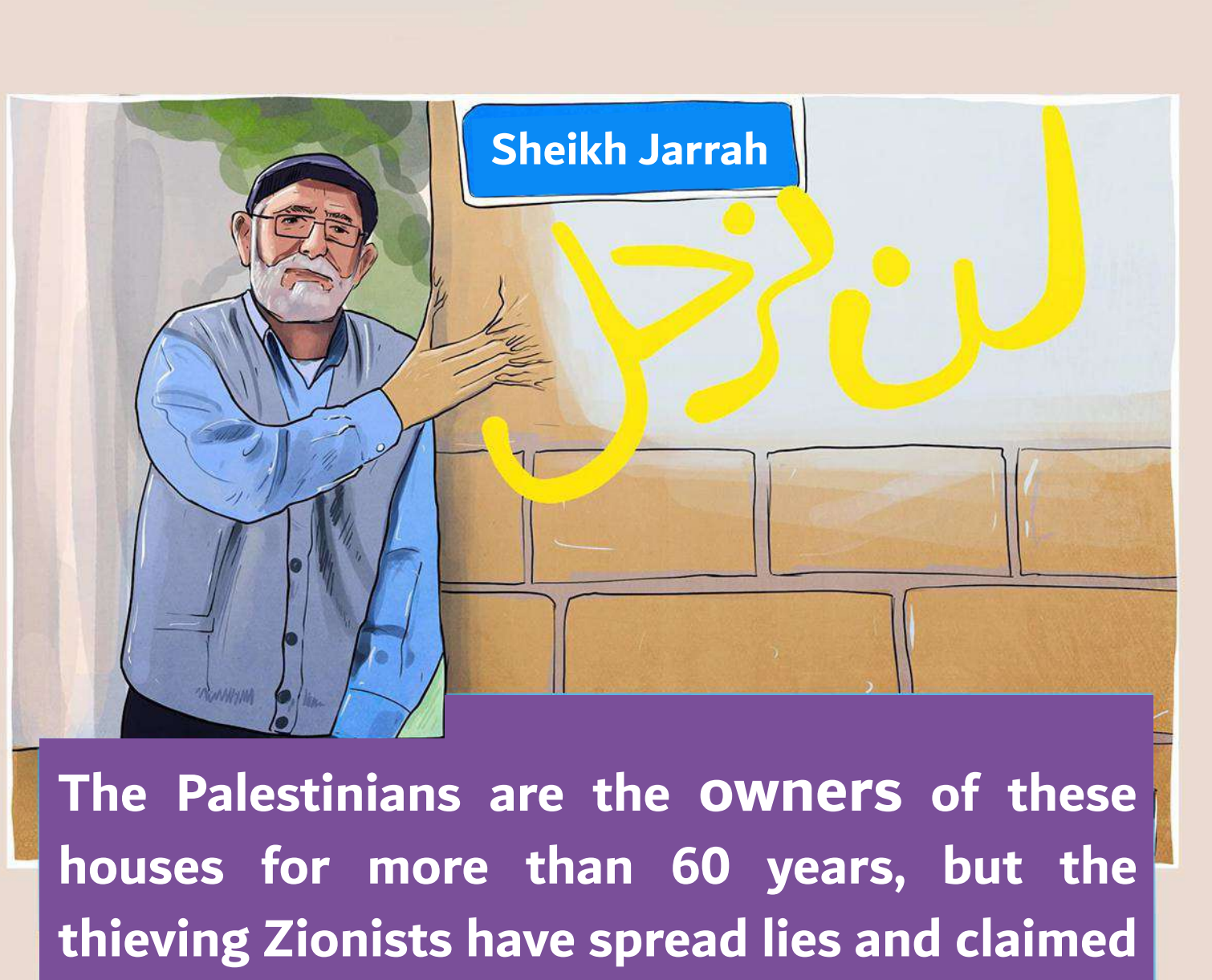

So what's the story? This is exactly what is happening to the children in the Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood in occupied Al-Quds.

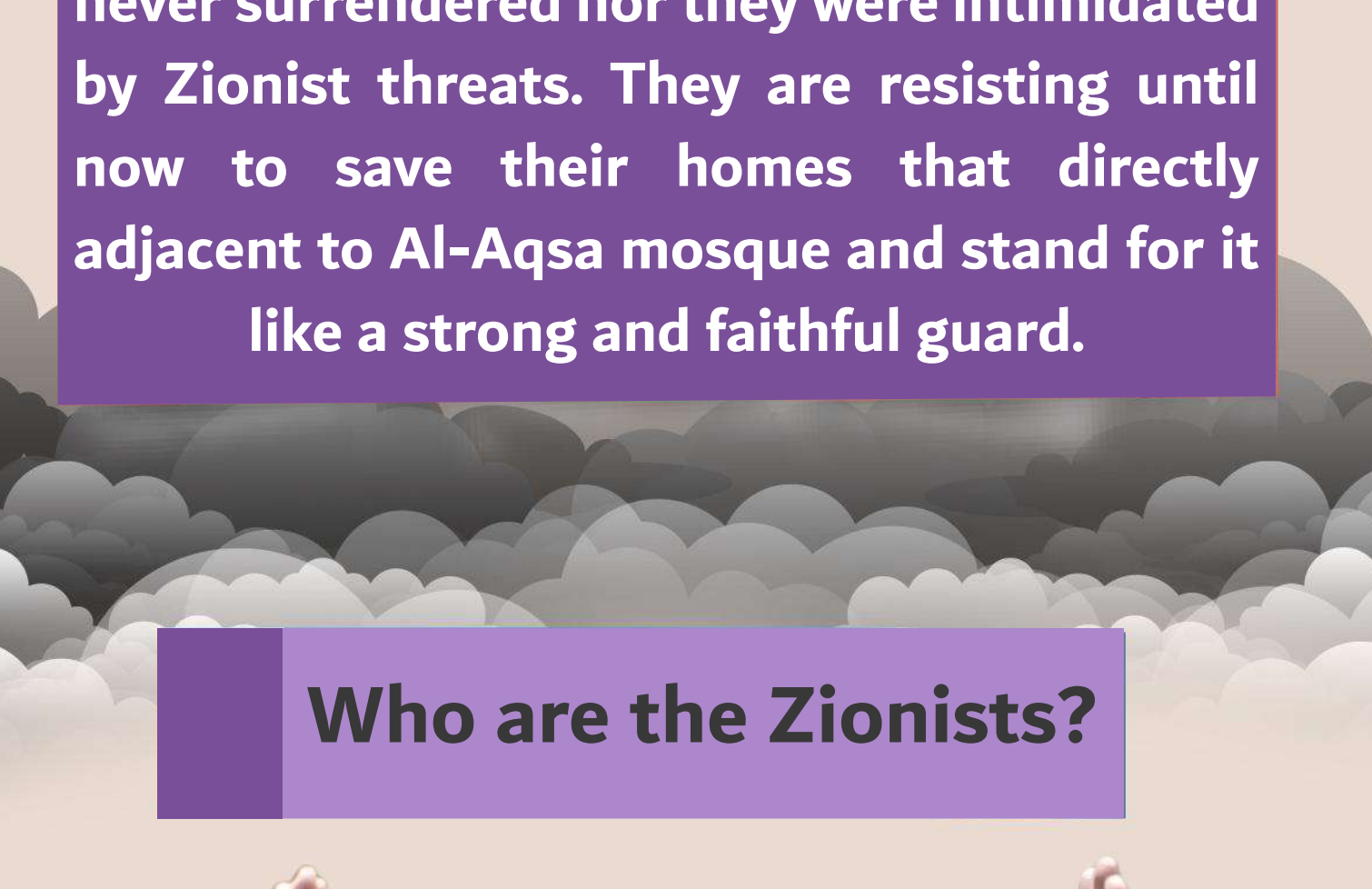


Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood

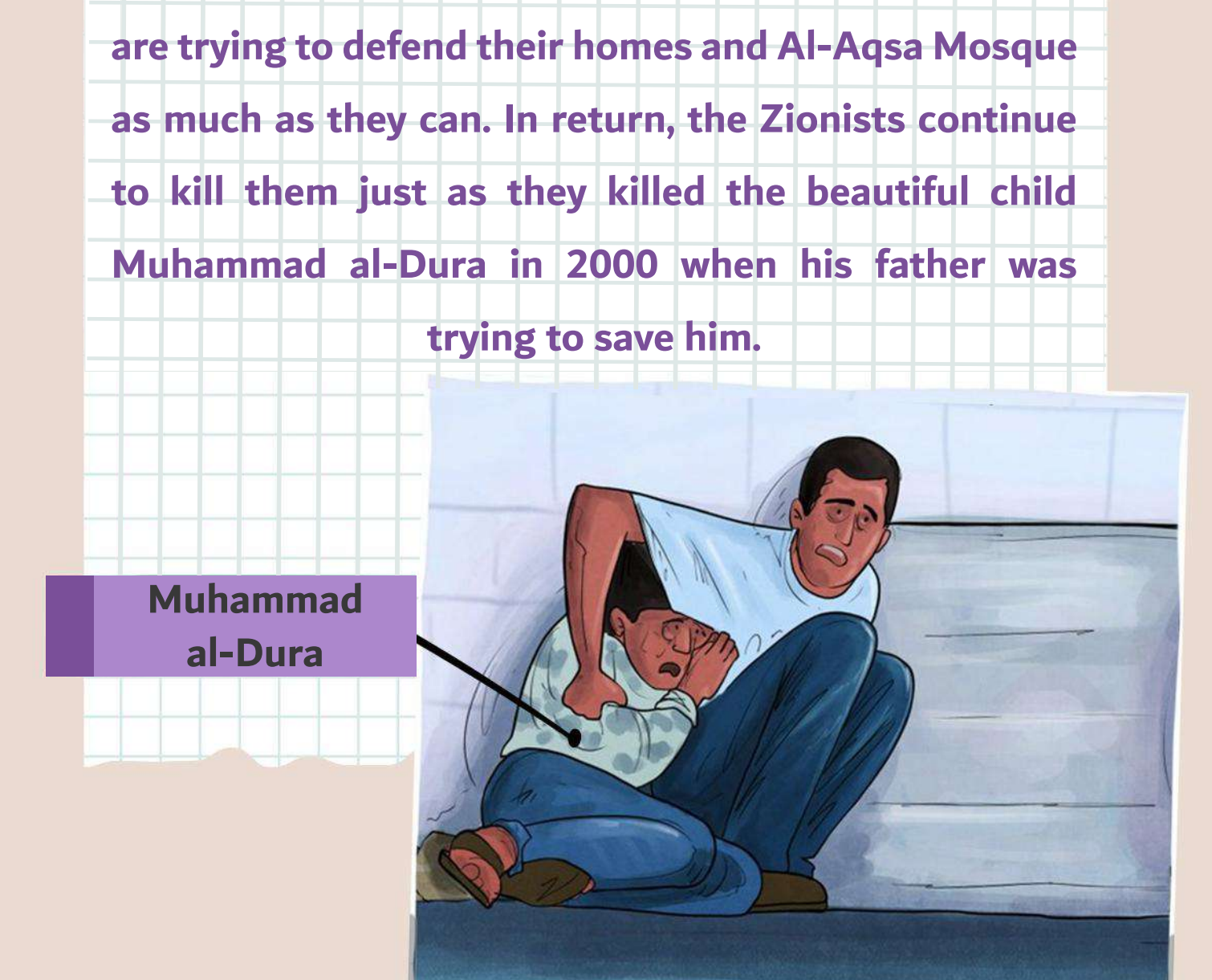

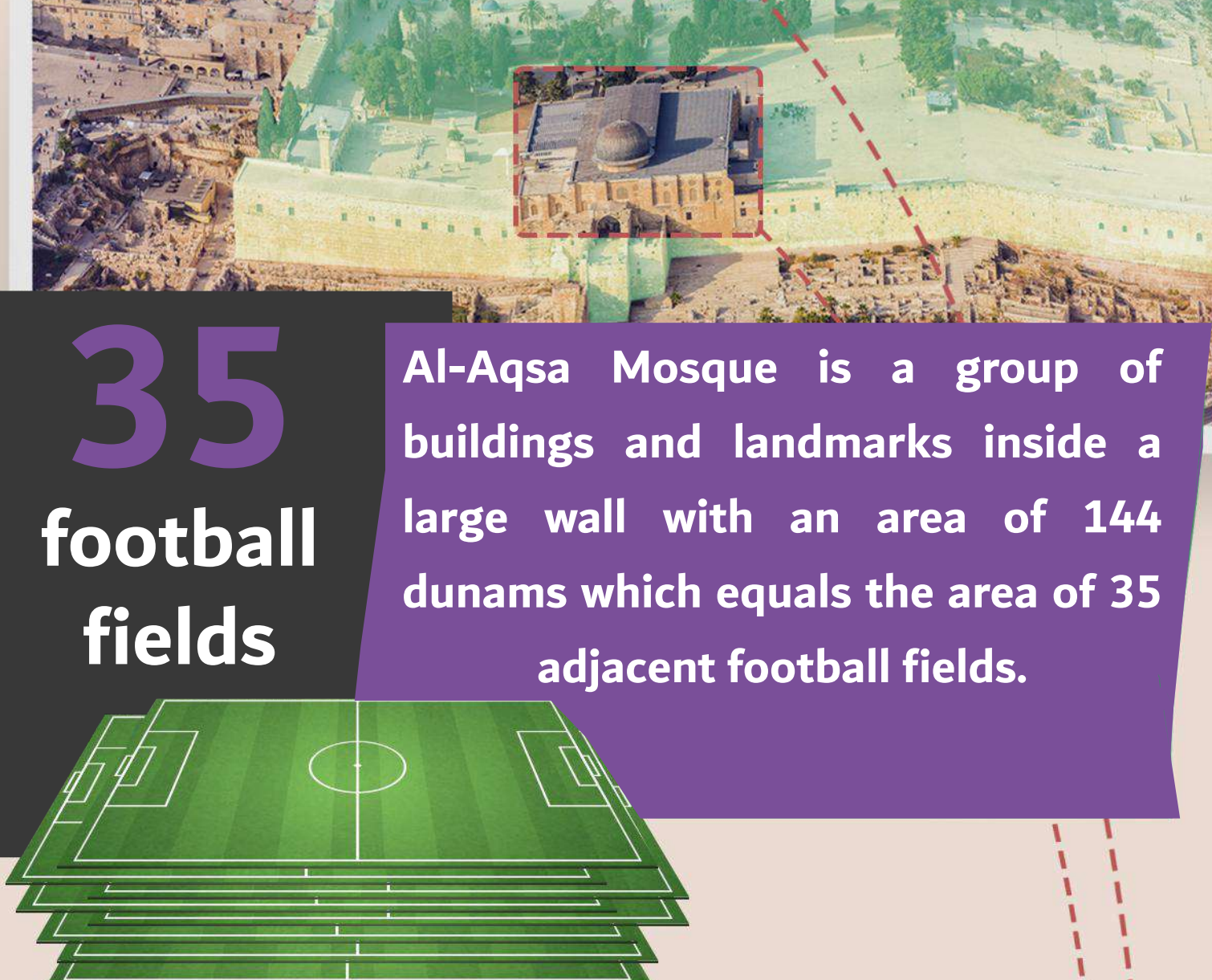

Who are the Zionists?

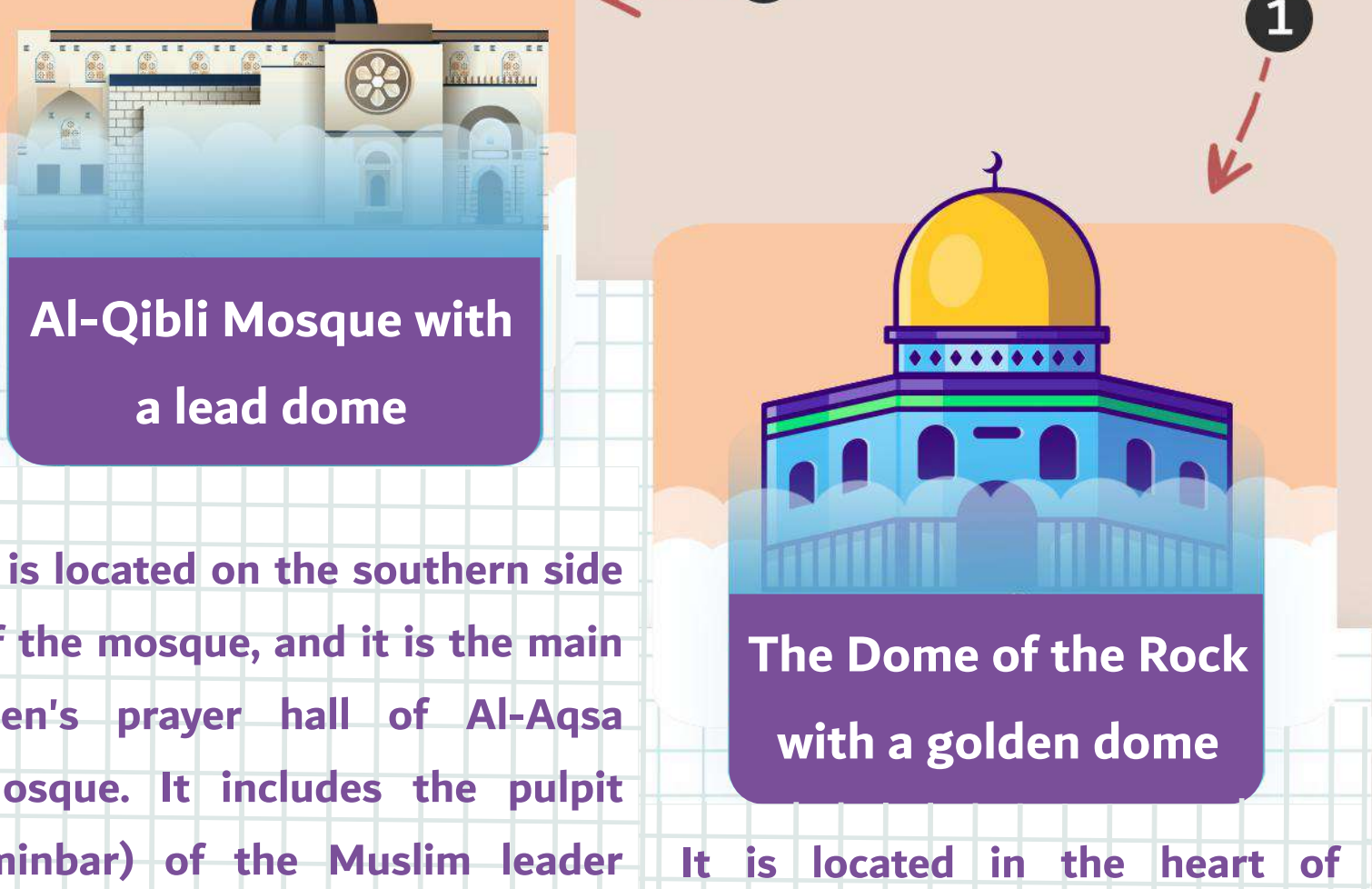

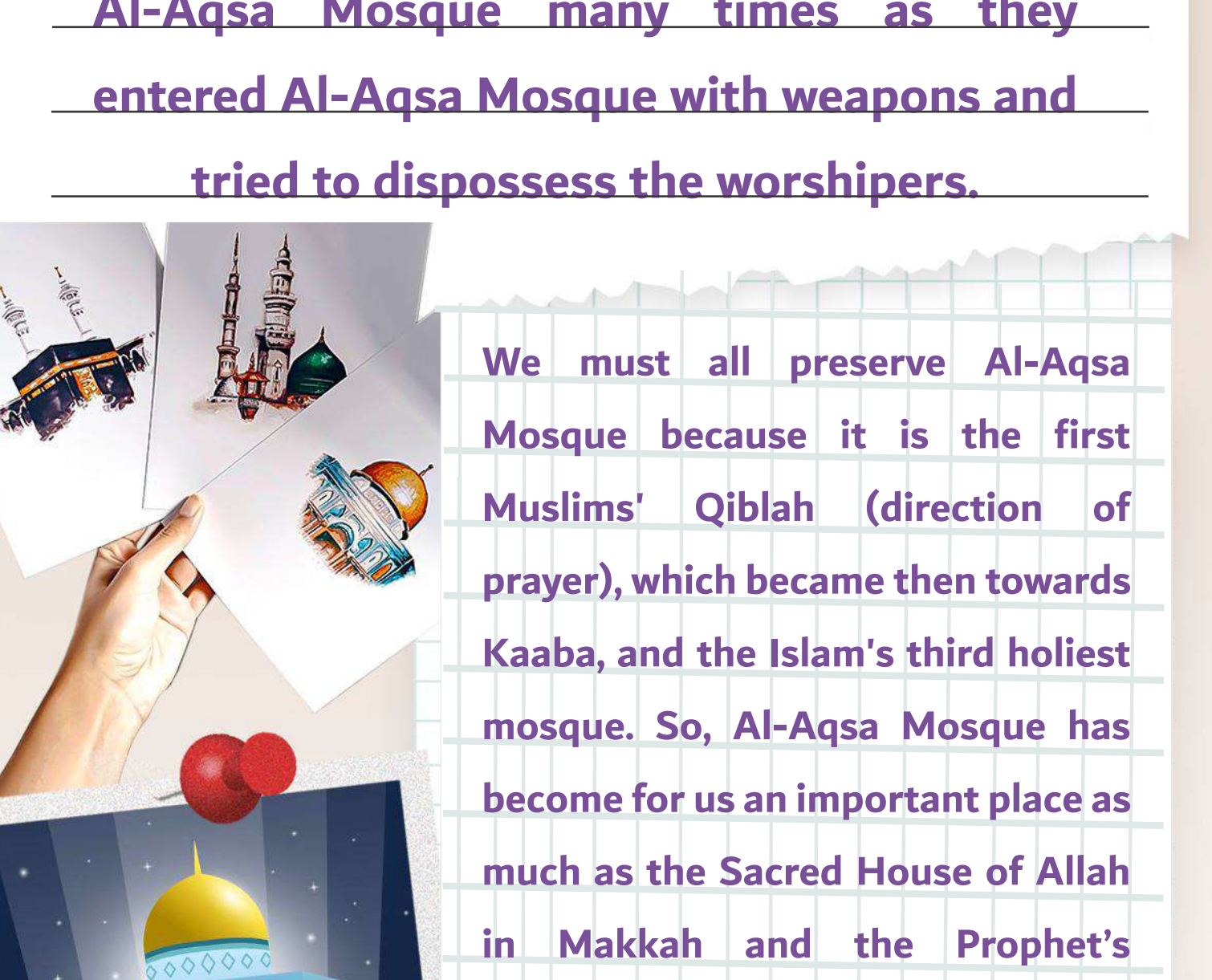
The occupation has been going on for many years, and until now, the Zionists are trying every day to achieve their dream of expanding their state and controlling all the land of Palestine.

Al-Aqsa Mosque is a group of buildings and landmarks inside a large wall with an area of 144 dunams which equals the area of 35 adjacent football fields.

Everything within this large space is part of Al-Aqsa Mosque, including: Squares, doors, prayer places, wells, trees, terraces, etc.

The number of buildings and landmarks in it exceeds 200, the most important of these are:

It is located on the southern side of the mosque, and it is the main men's prayer hall of Al-Aqsa Mosque. It includes the pulpit (minbar) of the Muslim leader Salah al-Din al-Ayyubi.

It is located in the heart of Al-Aqsa Mosque. It is an octagonal building that has the rock from which it is believed that the Prophet Muhammad, peace be upon him, ascended to the heaven. This mosque is known among the visitors of Al-Aqsa as the women's prayer hall.

The Zionists managed to break into Al-Aqsa Mosque many times as they entered Al-Aqsa Mosque with weapons and tried to dispossess the worshippers.

We must all preserve Al-Aqsa Mosque because it is the first Muslims' Qiblah (direction of prayer), which became then towards Kaaba, and the Islam's third holiest mosque. So, Al-Aqsa Mosque has become for us an important place as much as the Sacred House of Allah in Makkah and the Prophet's Mosque in Medina.
