Some of the threatened sites are:



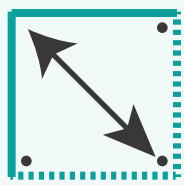
Roman amphitheater

A diameter of 110m



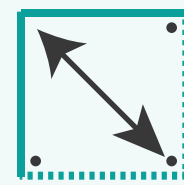
Deer Saman

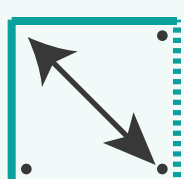
Dar Al Dharb

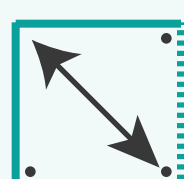
Deer Al Qala'a
